It's a rather simple formula: content is community. It's been that way for centuries, which is why we so easily forget that people are not meant to live alone in splendid isolation, but rather to live with and for other people. Thanks to a series of leadership-oriented education webinars in 2011, I gained an abundance of new knowledge to add to the many insights I've picked up over the years. I also learned a great deal about webinars - and about the importance of small group discussions as part of the webinar process. One of the topics covered in the webinar was the concept of community and its importance as the cornerstone of a better-educated citizenry. A city is not just a building; it's a living organism with a soul and a heart. It has a group of people who make up the city, and these people are the basis for a successful city. In a beautiful recent study, sociologist Saskia Sassen investigated five large global cities and found that their sense of community was more important to the success of their citizens than the most popular political party, economic policy, culture, or the quality of the schools. "Sociologists and journalists have long debated the factors that govern social behavior and economic success," writes Sassen in her book - "Expanding the Boundaries of Community: Globalization, Citizenship, and the City." "Has culture and economic policy shaped society, or has society shaped the economy? Has the creation of diverse economic opportunities for citizens generated the cultural openness necessary for social cooperation?" "From this perspective, of course, a city is not just a physical place but a social and cultural environment," she writes.
